Flame Run celebrates *Women in Glass*



Flame Run contemporary glass art studio and gallery is celebrating women glass artists with "Women in Glass," an exhibit that features the work of nationally recognized artists and their local counterparts, from June 1 through July 28.

Stephanie Trenchard, Laurel Hagner, Karen Willenbrink-Johnsen and Meredith Masser will headline the show, which includes seven Louisville artists.

"I love to see the sensitivities to emotion and passion in so many women's glass art," said Flame Run co-owner Susie Slabaugh. "I see an

awesome reflection and celebration of the global interconnection of women."

Wisconsin's Trenchard will open the show with a demonstration of sculpting and glass-casting techniques at 6 p.m. on June 1. Hagner and gallery director Naomi Stuecker will offer a kiln-casting workshop June 2-3 from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The exhibit also will include the work of several other local artists, including Slabaugh, Devyn Baron, Amy Pender, Casey McMains, Tiffany Ackerman and Jeanne Joseph.
